

Tuition Payment Policy

The Philadelphia Project (TPP) provides preschool, afterschool, and summer programs to enrich the lives of our neighborhood families. As a non-profit, we strive to offer high-quality, Christ-centered programs that are affordable to most families. If financial assistance is needed, a scholarship program is available.

TPP relies on tuition to meet our payroll and other expenses. Please respect our payment policy so that we can continue to serve the whole community. If you have questions or are struggling with financial issues, please contact the director in person or via email preschool@thephiladelphiaproject.com.

1. Payments are due the first of each month in advance (Example: January tuition is due January 1st).
2. Any family with past-due balance is subject to a tuition conference scheduled by the director.
3. Partial scholarships are available for families who are unable to afford our tuition. Applications may be made at any time. There are limited funds for these scholarships and not all applications will be approved.
4. Families who have applied for Scholarship remain responsible for full tuition until the scholarship amount is determined.
5. Families who have not met their tuition obligation (full or scholarship-reduced) for a period of two months may not continue in any TPP program.
6. Students with a past balance from prior term may remain in the program if the current tuition (full or scholarship amount) is paid and the parent is paying for past-due amounts as agreed.
7. Students who have been excluded for non-payment, may return to TPP programs with 1) a mutually-agreed payment plan; 2) payment of current month's tuition; and 3) first payment of the payment plan. As long as you are current on your payment plan for your past balance and current on tuition payments, your child may remain in the program.
