Job Summary

The Summer Camp Ministry Interns will have an opportunity to gain valuable experience in Children's Ministry through deep integration in the planning and execution of The Philadelphia Project's (TPP) Summer Camp Program. Interns will live and work in community with other TPP Interns who serve in TPP's Summer of Service (SOS). Their primary responsibility will be the planning and execution of the daily programmatic, relational, and spiritual elements of our Kid's Camp experiences. The Summer Camp Ministry Interns will also provide support to the Summer of Service evening programs.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Maintain a positive, teachable attitude in all things, remaining Christ centered in life
- Work with the camp staff to facilitate activities, Bible lessons, and workshops during camp hours
- Provide instruction, motivation, encouragement to engage with each camper in an enthusiastic and supportive way
- Help to enforce the rules and policies of camp, including being familiar with safety regulations and emergency procedures.
- Provide servant leadership and direction for volunteers
- Perform general office tasks as needed
- Assist with evening meals and facilitate the transitions of the SOS schedule
- Participate in SOS evening club through games, worship, and sharing testimonies.
- Live in community at The Project and attend Roxborough Church as they serve alongside one another for the entirety of internship
- Develop relationships with members of our church community & the surrounding neighborhood
- Attend Staff Orientation, trainings, and daily staff meetings
- Other duties as assigned by senior staff

- A willingness and ability to demonstrate and articulate one's Christian faith
- A deep love for people as valuable in God's sight
- A commitment to racial reconciliation as a primary mission of the church
